Admission Requirements

International candidates must possess an equivalent qualification of the Malaysian High School Certificate (STPM) or a Diploma recognised by the Malaysian Government.

Equivalent Qualification

- 1. A good pass in O-levels/its equivalent
- 2. A pass in the A-levels with at least a C Grade in three (3) subjects
- 3. A Band 3 in the Malaysian University English Test (MUET) or a TOEFL score of at least 550 or a score of 6 in the IELTS examination;

AND has fulfilled special requirements for the programme i.e. attaining the required grades in (sciences/arts) as specified for each UPM Bachelor programme

OR Equivalent Qualification

- 1. A pass in the Higher School Certificate (HSC)/its equivalent with at least a C+ grade in three (3) subjects or 65% in three (3) subjects in the Final Level of Secondary Education
- 2. A pass in the University Entrance Exam (for countries which seek such requirement for admission into universities)
- 3. A Band 3 in the Malaysian University English Test (MUET) or a TOEFL score of at least 550 or a score of 6 in the IELT'S examination;

AND has fulfilled special requirements for the programme i.e. attaining the required grades in (sciences/arts) as specified for each UPM Bachelor programme

OR Equivalent Qualification

- 1. A Diploma or its equivalent which is recognised by the Malaysian Government and the University Senate with a CGPA of at least 3.00
- 2. A Band 3 in the Malaysian University English Test (MUET) or a TOEFL score of at least 550 or a score of 6 in the IELTS examination;

AND has fulfilled special requirements for the programme i.e. attaining the required grades in (sciences/arts) as specified for each UPM Bachelor programme.

English Language Proficiency -**Requirement for International Students**

A. DIRECT ADMISSION

For direct admission, the applicant must have obtained one of the following

- 550 for the TOEFL Paper-based Test (Academic Version);
- ii. Band 6.0 for IELTS (Academic Training);
- 79-80 for TOEFL Internet-based Test (Academic Version); or iii.
- iv. 213 for TOEFL Computer-based Test (Academic Version).

The validity period for requirement should not be more than five (5) years. TOEFL ITP is not an acceptable alternative.

B. PROVISIONAL ADMISSION*

A provisional admission is given to the following:

An applicant who obtains lower than:

550 for the TOEFL Paper-based Test (Academic Version); or band 6.0 for IELTS (Academic Training).

* "PROVISIONAL ADMISSION" status for international students

An international student with "Provisional Admission" status is known as a Non-Graduating student.

C. EXEMPTION FROM ENGLISH LANGUAGE PROFICIENCY REQUIREMENT

An applicant who has undergone his/her secondary school in Malaysia shall not be subject to the English Language i. proficiency requirement. Application for exemption must be accompanied by supporting documents that have been certified by the relevant certificate-issuing bodies.

CERTIFIED INTENSIVE ENGLISH PROGRAMME (CIEP) - ELS

The Certified Intensive English Programme (CIEP) is conducted by ELS and ideal for university-bound students who want to achieve the required English proficiency for admission into UPM's degree courses in the shortest time possible. CIEP is a full time programme with 28 hours of intensive English classes a week during the 4 weeks (one session) of each level, from beginner to advanced levels (100-109). Besides UPM, the CIEP certificate from ELS Language Centres is also recognised as an entry requirement by many universities and colleges worldwide in place of TOEFL and IELTS.

* Both of these criteria can apply and a student may apply for CIEP with the status of a Non-Graduating student. Applicants who have applied for CIEP are not allowed to register for or take any academic courses during the CIEP.

Acceptance of Offer

All successful applicants are required to read all appendices in the offer letter. All appendices enclosed with the offer letter are treated as part of the applicant's acceptance of the rules and condition of studying in UPM. Successful applicants are required to reply to the offer letter within 14 days from the date of the receipt.

Academic Division

- Please complete your registration at the Academic Division Office, 1st Floor, Administration Building, Universiti Putra Malaysia, 43400 UPM SERDANG, Selangor Darul Ehsan.
- b. Please bring the following documents during registration for verification:
 - i. The original offer letter of admission.
 - ii. All the original supporting documents for verification:
 - Original copy of Higher School Certificate (HSC) / GCE 'A' Level / Diploma or equivalent
 - Original copy of Academic Transcript from your previous university / college / school
 - Original copy of TOEFL / IELTS /MUET result
 - International passport
 - Original copy of applicant's Financial Statement OR Letter of Undertaking from the sponsor
 - iii. Verified Certification of Medical Examination Report form.
 - iv. Submit two passport-sized photographs with BLUE background.
 - Submit all the completed required forms to the relevant office as stated in the form.
 - vi. Prospective students who fail to provide the above mentioned documents shall not be allowed to register.

Health Examination Report

 a. Please have your health examination in your home country by completing the Universiti Putra Malaysia Health Examination Report of International Student form enclosed.

All successful applicants are advised to read the Health Examination Guidelines for Entry into Malaysian Higher Educational Institutions carefully before filling in the form.

- b. Health examination can be done at applicant's home country before departure.
- c. Submit the completed Universiti Putra Malaysia Health Examination Report of International Student form and the Certification of Medical Examination Report form to the University Health Centre for verification.
- d. A candidate who is found to have any of the diseases/disorders that prohibit registration during a verification process by UPM's Health Centre will be required to return to his/her home country at his/her own expense.

Bursar Payment Counter

The university and faculty will not be responsible for securing financial support for the duration of your study period.

- a. Please pay the basic and credit fees at the Bursar's payment counter on the Ground Floor, Administration Building, Payment can be made in cash or by credit card or debit card (Please refer to the respective rate of studies fee as attached in the offer letter of admission)
- ONLINE payment can be made through Cimbclick. Please refer to the Bursar's payment counter for assistance.

Student Affairs Division

This division handles students' health insurance scheme. This insurance scheme is **COMPULSORY** for all international students **including those students who already have other individual insurance**.

Residential Colleges (Accommodation)

All international students are required to **register** at their **respective** colleges.

UPM International Sdn. Bhd. (UPMI)

Application for a student pass must be done 2 weeks prior to the registration date. Successful candidates are required to submit Student Pass application to UPMI.

Submit the following documents to UPMI for Student Pass application:

- a. Offer letter from Universiti Putra Malaysia.
- b. Nationals from The People's Republic of China and Commonwealth Independent States who wish to study in Public Educational Institutions are required to obtain prior consent from the Department of Higher Education, Ministry of Education Malaysia.
- c. Nationals from the People's Republic of China are required to obtain Entry Visa prior to entering Malaysia.
- d. Completed Form IMM. 14 in duplicate.
 i. Two (2) copies of Passport/ Travel Document
 - ii. Two (2) passport sized photographs
- Except for nationals from The People's Republic of China, other nationals who have obtained approval to study through their respective Educational Institutions are allowed direct entry into Malaysia.
- f. Students have to show their approval letters upon arrival.
- g. A Special Pass will be issued to refer them to the respective State Immigration Department for issuance of a Student Pass.

UPMI is also responsible for non-academic matters that include a wide range of guidance, pre-departure and upon arrival transportation and guide to living and studying in Universiti Putra Malaysia.

Faculty

All international students are required to **register** their subjects at their **respective faculty**.

Life at UPM

Student Life

Cost of Living

The cost of living for international students studying at UPM is reasonably low compared to international standards, and can vary from RM 900 - 1,200 (USD 300 - 400) a month (not inclusive of accommodation) depending on individual needs. Necessary facilities and amenities are readily available within the campus and its vicinity to make the life of a student much easier.

Culture

Malaysian culture is an amalgamation of all the different ethnicities that are found within the country. At UPM, the cultural diversity is further enriched by the presence of more than 3000 international students who are enrolled in UPM.

Safety

Students' safety is taken seriously at UPM. UPM's security personnel patrol the campus frequently and are always at hand to offer assistance as and when necessary.

Entertainment & Shopping

UPM's main campus is a 20-minute drive away from Kuala Lumpur, the capital city of Malaysia. Students can access the nation's top entertainment, shopping and cultural centres via a rapid city rail service.

Currency

The monetary unit of Malaysia is Ringgit Malaysia (RM). The exchange rate is at the time of printing USD 1 = RM 3.00 (subject to fluctuations). Foreign currencies can be exchanged at banks and money changers.

Part-time Employment

Students can work during vacations with the permission of the Malaysian Immigration Department.

Accommodation

The on-campus accommodation provides great value-for-money and are situated inclose proximity to campus facilities, transport and other important consumer services. There are two (2) types of accommodation within the UPM campus which are available for international students which include student apartments which comprise 2-bedroom and 1-bathroom flats, and residential colleges, which comprise twin sharing rooms with common facilities. International students are advised to reserve their accommodation before coming to Malaysia as apartments and rooms in residential colleges are limited. The cost of accommodation can vary from USD 100-500 a month.

Off-campus accommodation around the UPM campus is within the radius of 1 – 10 km. There are various types of accommodation which include flats, service apartments, condominiums and terrace houses. The cost of accommodation can vary from RM 450 - 1,050 (USD 150-650) a month.





Transportation

Students' transportation inside and outside of campus is well taken care of via the UPM coach services. Each student is expected to pay approximately USD 20 per semester for unlimited rides. UPM's Student Affairs Division has also allocated more than 20 university buses to cater to students' academic and co-curricular activities outside the campus. UPM's covered bus stops are equipped with fans, lights and notice boards to maximise students' comfort.

Food

There is a wide range of cafeteria, restaurants and food stalls available within the campus and in the surrounding neighbourhood. Food can be obtained at any hour, for, besides the cafeterias at faculties, many eat-outs in the vicinity are open 24 hours. Among well-known fast-food outlets available in the vicinity are McDonalds and Kentucky Fried Chicken.

Health & Welfare

All international students can access outpatient clinic services provided at the University Health Centre which is located within the campus. The health centre provides a comprehensive array of health services and is well-equipped with modern facilities and pharmaceutical amenities which enable the efficient provision of effective health and dental services to all registered students and staff. Among facilities and services available at the centre are medical, dental, x-ray, physiotherapy, ambulance service, dispensary, laboratory etc.

IT Facility

UPM's IT infrastructure provides a range of facilities and services to assist students with their IT-related needs. Wireless hotspots and access to the Internet and other online resources including Library e-resources/e-journals and student portals are readily available throughout the university.

Research Facilities

Cutting-edge research facilities include a sophisticated imaging facility for biological and material science investigations, a GMP-certified plant to produce animal bacterial vaccines and probiotics, an advanced biosafety lab for studying dangerous pathogens, high-end mass spectrometers for chemical studies, and a supercritical fluid centre for food science research and various other high-tech laboratories.

Sports & Recreation

UPM's sports facilities are numerous and are aimed at encouraging and supporting its students in their sports initiatives. UPM's commitment to sports can be seen by the dedicated block for athletes, built at the University's Sixth College. UPM also has a swimming pool, a sports complex with a main stadium for track and field events, a multipurpose hall (for indoor games such as squash, netball, sepaktakraw, volleyball, basketball), a golf course, an equine park etc.

Amenities

Basic amenities available within the campus include a post office, bank, bookshop, optical shop, etc.





International Support Services

UPM International Sdn. Bhd. (UPMI)

UPM International Sdn. Bhd. supports the university's mission to become a university of international repute. It is basically responsible for providing all the necessary support to international students who are studying at UPM.

International Student Association (UPMISA)

UPMISA is a student association for international students studying at UPM and is basically responsible for fostering good relationship among all international students of UPM by organising various interaction programmes and activities.
